

# Note from the President

First of all, I want to thank Ron for running the meeting for me last month as Kim and I were in Texas seeing coastal lighthouses and attending the MCA's Regional Director's Meeting. This was my first time at a Regional Director's Summit, and not being a Regional Director, I didn't have a vote, but I assure you that I was not a quiet mouse in the corner. As a non-for-profit organization we can be subject to a tax audit by the IRS, even though we do not file a tax return. We must check to see if we are a 501-3(c) nonprofit. I have looked at our club's by-laws and there in nothing listed in them that states what our tax/non-tax code is. Now. I doubt that the IRS would ever audit our small club, but we can never sav never and it's best to have all our I's dotted and our T's crossed.

I bring this up because one Regional club was audited and was found to be a 501-3(d) class non-profit, which meant that any thing given to the club was non-deductible to the person giving it. For years, every show I attend, every prize, sponsorship I purchased I kept a receipt and deducted it on my income taxes. You wouldn't think it was much, but last year it was over \$1,200.00 for Kim and I. If I had been audited and those had gone to a non 501-3(c) non-for-profit, I would have be liable for the

this also pertains to a club's charity, so we just want to make sure everything is legit. In the case of the one regional club being audited the MCA did step in and help them, as to why this was brought up at the Summit.

I have had Kim working on getting our club logo registered with Ford. This is a no or small cost to the club, and with today's legalities it is only right to do so. Within six months Ford Performance will be doing something for all clubs, but will wait and let Kim tell you about that, but having our club logo as a registered trademark with Ford will help facilitate that as well.

Now let's move on to other things.

At the November meeting we will be voting for Club Officers (President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer). Nominations are still open and anyone still wishing to run for an office is still able. Those in appointed positions as per club by-laws (Publicity Director, MCA Director, Newsletter Editor, Activities Director and Webmaster) who wish to step down from these positions or anyone who would like to fill one of these positions is also open to be voted upon by the members. So if you have ever wanted the chance for any one of these offices/positions, now is your chance.

I want to thank all club members who participated at Glen Moore Park in Alton, Weber Ford's Grand Opening in Granite City, Theresa and Jeff's bonfire and our cruise to Lincoln Nation's in Mt. Vernon. But most of these events were not listed on out events page/calendar on our web site. We must do a better job of updating our web site in a timely manner. On October 27th at Janet's house was held another web site training session and its hoped these problems will be resolved for future events.
