Note from the President

Rainy Days and Mondays--

First let me say thank you for your vote of confidence in me at the last meeting. Believe me when I say it was an honest mistake and not a "better to ask for forgiveness instead of permission moment", on our incorporation. This incorporation is only making our club a non-for-profit. It has nothing to do with 501-3(c) charitable contributions and does not require us to file a state tax return. The only thing this covers is that members within the club cannot be sued personally if an accident/incident should happen while on a club activity. We have yearly and show insurance that covers these and it is under the club only. So each and every club member should feel at ease. In today's world which it seems everyone is out for a free dollar and are sue happy, it only makes sense and should have been done a long time before this. As President, it is my responsibility to look after the best interest of the club and its members. Judy and I met and all the forms were filled out, notarized and sent off. I have a copy of those forms and anyone who wants to see them can, at any meeting. The only thing we have to do in the future is an Annual Report each year by March 31st with a filing fee of \$15.00

To become a 501-3(c) would require Federal and State paperwork, with much more cost in filing fees and would require filing both Federal and State tax returns. As we are a smaller club, I personally believe that this would be to time and finically consuming. If we were to host an MCA National Show, it would be required. But I believe if we want an MCA National Show we could always join in with Central Illinois Mustang Club in Springfield as they host a National about every 5 years or so, if they were willing.

With our incorporation paperwork, Judy was able to get our club checking account up and running again. We also now have a club debit card, which use is only authorized by the clubs Treasurer and/or club President, for items that cannot be paid via check (our website fees). This will also prevent members from having to use their personal credit/debit cards for club purchases.

Being we have not received a renewal for our yearly club insurance, I called and asked why not? Now, Kim received a packet from this company last fall, and when it was sent to her we thought it was in reference to her applying for the Mustang II reunion in 2019, as nothing in it referenced renewal for our club. Luckily, Kim kept that packet and when I called was informed that was our clubs renewal. The forms have been filled out, Judy wrote the check and has been mailed out, so our yearly insurance has been paid and we are covered for our Mustang Day cruise in April 7th.

As of April 1st, we will be just over 100 days from our annual show, so keep working in those Sponsorships/Raffle/Attendance Prizes. At last count Larry has 7 Sponsorships so far and we would like to get 20 or better this year, but can only accomplish this with your help.

In the last month our garage crew has been busy with trips I know to my house and to Jeff & Theresa's. We have a very talented bunch so speak up if you need help and/or assistance, it's there for the asking.

Our day a Mecum in Kansas City was great and will let Ron tell you about that at the next club meeting, but we did earn a contact with Mecum Auctions and should be getting discounts for further auctions in the future.




