# Note from the President

## Time is Running Short--

Here it is June already and we are down to little over a month till our show in July. We still have a lot of things to do yet, but as always it all seems to come together. And as always, we are in need of attendance prizes and/or raffle items for our silent auction. I have already begun to get phone calls and e-mails from people wanting to attend our show with various Fords, Lincoln's and Mercury's this year so it looks like we'll have guite a variety of cars attending. So let's pray and keep our fingers crossed for good weather.

Our club has been out and about quite a bit since our last meeting. On the 19th we held our National Mustang Day Cruise to Burgers, Shakes and Fries in Litchfield, then down Route 66 to Soulby's Shell gas station in Mt. Olive and on to Country Classic's in Staunton. There was to be an ice cream stop after that, but Kim and I left after Country Classic's as I worked the night before and both of us had to work that night. We had 11 cars so I still have window decals left if anyone would like one at the upcoming meeting,

After our last meeting I received an e-mail from John Roberts that the HoonDog Route 66 Bullitt Cruise traveling from Chicago to California on old Route 66 during Memorial Day weekend and sponsored by Ford, Team Mustang, Ford Performance and HoonDog Performance Group, and that he would like our clubs involvement. Through various e-mails back and forth between HoonDog and myself as to the date and route, it was finally found out that they would be stopping at Soulby's Shell gas station in Mt. Olive at 1:00PM on the 26th, and that we would be welcomed to join their cruise for any part of it. With an e-mail blast to all club members, we met at Love's truck stop in Hamel and cruised up to Mt. Olive and were able to set up our club banner on the corner across the street from Soulby's.

We were able to socialize under the gas stations front overhang during a brief rainstorm while we waited for the Bullitt cruise to show up and were joined by several members of the Central Illinois Mustang Club. The HoonDog Bullitt cruise arrived about 2:20 PM with two 2019 prototype Bullitt Mustangs and 61 other Mustang and Bullitt cars, and we were given an impromptu demonstration of the 2019 Bullitt's features. Most club members chose to cruise to Worden instead of joining the HoonDog Bullitt cruise to St. Louis Veterans Center, opting for the memorial car show for Doug Behme, a young Mustang fan who tragically died in a workplace gas explosion in Glen Carbon a couple of years ago.

On the 27th, Kim and I were notified by Legendary Mustang Sanctuary that Channel 2 News was featuring them on their morning news show on May 30 to promote the cruise-in at Bethalto airport on June 2nd and requested three cars there for the Mustang's For Mustang's event.
