As if we had known we could have presented him a check. If we keep this charity, I would suggest that we have a dedicated club member who can act as liaison between our club and the Hope Center.

If we decide to change any or all of our charities, I would remind all club members that any charity should be in and affect our local community. We are a club in the community and should be able to see or understand where our charity money is going to.

As of January 1st, Preregistration is open for the Mustang II Reunion IV which will be part of our Round-up this year. If preregistration is anything like the Mustang II web sites with those who say they are planning to attend, we should have a good turnout.


