This month we will start to take nominations for all club officers for the upcoming year. I have reached the term limits, so let's be thinking who we would like to lead our club in the upcoming year.

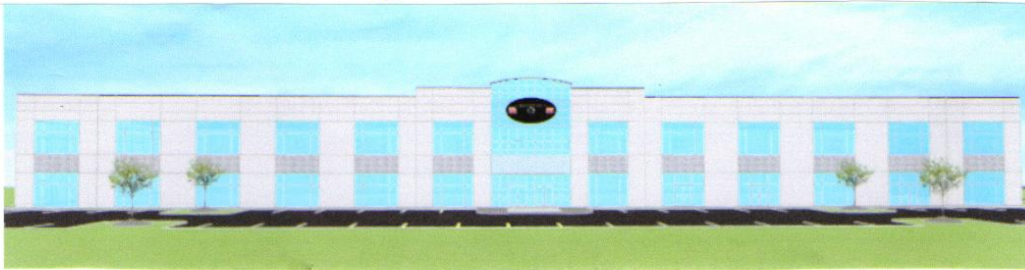
Are prayers are with Judy and Ollie and their family in their time of need, and we offer strength and thoughts as they move through this troubled time.
