50/50 was won by Larry Roseberry.

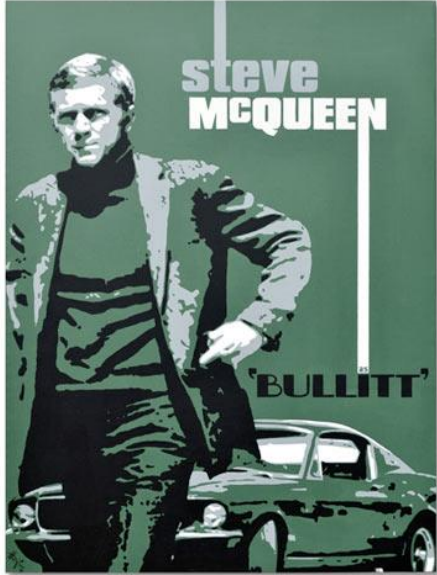

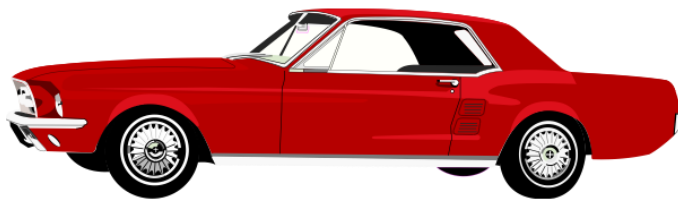


## Save The Dates

**A note from Randy**

Greetings fellow Mustang enthusiasts – may the luck of the Irish be with each of you!

With the upcoming collaboration between our club and Wildey Theatre in showing the 1968 feature film Bullitt, following are interesting bits of Bullitt trivia (all taken from the Internet).

1. The Ford Bullitt is a 1968 Mustang 390 GT 2+2 Fastback. The Dodge Charger is a 1968 440 Magnum. The Charger is just barely faster than the Mustang, with a 13.6–second quarter–mile to a 13.8–second quarter–mile.
2. In order to give the Mustang a stealthy appearance, Hollywood pared down the original 1968 by removing the driving lights, the running pony grill emblem, the Mustang lettering, and even the GT badges.
3. Two Mustangs and two Chargers were used for the filming of Bullitt. One Mustang and both Chargers were junked after filming. The junked Mustang, which was used for the jumps, tight turns, and speeding, was found in Mexico in 2017 in a junk yard. The Mustang that was used for “regular” driving was eventually sold for a whopping 3 million plus dollars in 2020.
4. Steve McQueen (Frank Bullitt – character name) shared driving time with another stunt driver. For interior shots, the rear-view mirror is down reflecting McQueen’s face. When the stunt driver drove, the rear-view mirror is up so that his face could not be seen. Steve McQueen’s wife insisted a stunt driver be used for certain scenes after he had an accident driving the 390 GT with a parked car.
5. Bullitt’s reverse burnout during the chase scene was not in the script – Steve McQueen had accidently missed the turn and the footage was kept.
6. Chase scenes involved speeds of over 110 mph. City officials may have been led to believe the chase scenes would not exceed 35 mph.
7. Filming the chase scene took three weeks, resulting in 9 minutes, 42 seconds of footage!

Wildey Theatre is asking how many Mustangs are planning on showing up for the Bullitt movie on April 18<sup>th</sup>. If there are 10+ Mustangs, they may be able to get permission to block off a section of College Street for everyone to park together. If members can show up around 5:00 p.m., we could use this as an opportunity to promote our club to increase membership. We appreciate club member Gayle Michel heading up this event.
