



Chevrolet.com reports "As we prepare to say goodbye to the current generation Camaro, it is difficult to overstate our gratitude to every Camaro customer said Scott Bell, vice president, Global Chevrolet." Ford Authority proclaims, "Ford Mustang Rival Chevy Camaro Officially Dead After 2024."

I say good riddance to the Camaro because when Camaro was first introduced in 1966 the automotive press asked Chevrolet product managers, "What is a Camaro?"
