A note from Randy

Greetings fellow Mustang enthusiasts – I think we all enjoyed the trip to Mecum. The group of us that went to Indianapolis saw a bunch of really nice cars. Steve sold his Willys and we all dreamed of owning an authentic million-dollar Cobra Mustang. I found the experience interesting in that the auctioneer's auction chants (bid calling, auction cry, the cattle rattle) spellbinding to say the least. One car that captured my attention was the 1970 Dodge Challenger "Black Ghost" which sold for \$1,072,500 at Mecum. Legend has it that the "426 cubic-inch V-8 would appear at night on Detroit's Woodward Avenue, a strip famous for impromptu (and illegal) drag races. The Challenger took on all comers, rarely losing. Then the car would disappear. The owner and his car never stopped by the local hamburger stand or any other street-racing gathering spots. Days could pass, and the car wouldn't show. It was a ghost – a black ghost with an alligator vinyl roof and unassuming little hubcaps." It was later found out that the car was owned by a black Detroit cop who had served in the U.S. Army and was awarded a Purple Heart in the mid-1960's. His racing antics had to remain a secret because he would have likely been fired from his job as a police officer had he been caught drag-racing his car. The owner and racer, Godfrey Qualls, has since passed away and turned the title over to his son who has now had the car auctioned off. Being in law enforcement all of my adult life, the story of the Black Ghost kind of gives me goosebumps.
