In celebration of the Mustang's birthday, I figured it would be appropriate to share a few trivia questions from *usefultrivia.com*.







- 1) What year was the earliest Ford Mustang model? 1964, 1963, 1966 or 1965? The answer is 1965. The early production versions are often referred to as "1964 ½ models" but all Mustangs were advertised, VIN coded and titled by Ford as 1965 models.
- 2) How much did the first Ford Mustang cost? \$3,484, \$2,368, \$2,944 or \$1,652? The first Mustang rolled off the assembly line March 9, 1964 with a list price of \$2,368.
- 3) In which film did James Bond drive a Ford Mustang? Diamonds Are Forever, Casino Royale, The Spy Who Loved Me, or A View to Kill? In the 1971 film, Diamonds Are Forever, 007 finds himself surrounded by cop cars on the Las Vegas Strip. Ford wanted the Mustang Mach 1 to be the car that James Bond used to escape. They had seen the rise in sales from other car companies after their appearances in James Bond films and wanted a piece of the action. They wanted it so bad that when a Mustang was destroyed while shooting the scene, Ford happily kept sending brand new ones to set.
- 4) What was the most expensive Ford Mustang ever sold? Shelby GT500 Super Snake, Shelby EXP 500 Green Hornet, Eagle Squadron Mustang GT, or Skyway Mustang? The collector's market for vintage Ford Mustangs received an unexpected jolt in 2019 when a one-off 1967 Shelby GT500 Super Snake went for \$2.2 million at a Florida auction, doubling pre-show estimates to become the most expensive Mustang ever sold.
