# JULY 2024 MEETING MINUTES

SIMA met at the Moose Lodge in Edwardsville on June 11th at 7:00p.m. President Randy Mueller called the meeting at 7:00pm. There were 29 members present. A motion was made by Dan M. and seconded by Kim S. to accept the May secretary's report. All approved. Larry R. gave the treasurer's report. A motion was made to accept the report by Paul B. and seconded by Steve S. It was approved by all.

#### MCA report (Kim Strickell): Notes from the April Board Meeting:

There are currently 14, 872 MCA members. More than half are standard members, which receive the Mustang Times. A reminder that on January 1, 2025, standard membership will increase to \$60 per year. You can renew early and not pay the increase until 2026. *May 24-26* was the Ponies in the Ozarks MCA National. 6 club members took their Mustangs. Larry and Pat Wesemann drove down on Saturday to check out the show which was a small show with 109 judged cars and 34 display and track cars. Derrick and Staci earned their red grill medallion and received a gold award with their 2006 vista blue GT convertible. Kim and Steve's Mustang II also received a gold award. Dorinda and Kim judged 3 cars. Dorinda was warned that there will be a lot more to judge in Des Moines. Randy judged 3 concours cars; each concours car takes 1-2 hours to judge as they have to be 100% original. Steve judged 6 cars and 1 concourse Mustang II. Dorinda received her judge's certificate. Steve earned his 15-show judged pin and Kim received her 10-show judged pin. There was good weather during the show and a beautiful location. On Saturday evening everyone got to do a parade lap on the track. Randy, Dorinda, Derrick and Staci took their Mustangs out while Steve and Kim drove the Maverick.
