## A note from Randy

Greetings fellow Mustang enthusiasts,

As you know, our car show is right around the corner. I encourage each of you to sign up as many sponsorships as you can for our trophies and to collect Hot Wheels and Matchbox scale model cars for our Christmas in July spectacular.

Speaking of Hot Wheels, I decided to learn a bit more about these incredible toys that I have played with for my entire life. Hot Wheels were introduced by Mattel on May 18, 1968. It was the primary competitor of Matchbox until Mattel bought Matchbox owner Tyco Toys in 1997.

In 1968, prior to the 1968 New York Toy Fair, the Mattel company invited a Kmart executive to its Los Angeles headquarters for a preview of its newest product (Hot Wheels). After watching a 1/64-scale muscle car replica shoot down a track and across the floor, the executive ordered 50 million cars on the spot. A custom Mustang was one of sixteen models featured in the debut set.

I learned that many automobile manufacturers have licensed Hot Wheels to make scale models of their cars, allowing the use of original design blueprints and detailing. Hot Wheels were originally made to be more like customized/modified cars.

Everyone who has ever played with or collected Hot Wheels has a favorite. Being of German descent, my favorite is the 1969 Red Baron with a white interior. These cars demand \$3,500 if you are seeking them. I just love the Stahlhelm helmet and the red line wheels/tires. Apparently, the Red Baron has been in production on and off again for decades. I believe my brother Kevin had one of these cars as a kid. Unfortunately, I don't know what ever happened to it. This car comes in at #15 as the most collectible Hot Wheels.

Coming in at #2 is the 1968 Over Chrome Mustang valued at \$40,000. OMG! Only two of this strawberry over chrome Mustang were produced. It was meant for advertising purposes, was for internal use only, and never sold. In case you are wondering, the 1969 Pink, Rear-Loading Beach Bomb would be worth \$175,000!!!



Hot wheels is celebrating 60 years of Ford Mustang in style. Five cars are featured: the 1984 SVO, 1969 Boss 302, 1971 Mach 1, 2018 RTR Spec 5, and my favorite year the 1965 2+2 Fastback. I guess now I have something else to hunt for at Walmart.







I look forward to seeing each of you at our upcoming meeting. Please consider attending a MCA event this summer. You know the Ponies in the Ozarks is just a hop, skip, and a jump away.
