OCTOBER 2024 MEETING MINUTES

A motion was made by Steve S. and seconded by Brian L. to accept the September secretary's report. All approved. Larry R. gave the treasurer's report. MCA report (Kim Strickell):

<u>A note from Randy</u>

Greetings fellow Mustang enthusiasts,

Happy Veterans Day to all the veterans and their families in the club. Last year, Secretary of Defense Lloyd J. Austin III, was quoted as saying, "To all our troops, veterans, and military families on this Veterans Day: Thank you for all that you have given to keep America safe. You have our deepest gratitude and our everlasting commitment to continue to uphold the values that you defended. President Biden said, "Our veterans are the steel spine of this nation. And their families ... are the courageous heart. Most Americans never see the sacrifices that you as family members also make." I say Amen to these comments.

I ask that at our next meeting, all veterans introduce themselves by providing which branch of service they served in as well as the years they served. I am certain that some of us are unaware of those who spent time on active duty or served in the reserves or national guard. Since I will be absent from the meeting, I would like to introduce myself as being a member of the U.S. Army from 1982-1988 as a Military Policeman, Military Police Investigator and a U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command Special Agent. The highlight of my service was meeting Dorinda whom I married. She'll introduce herself at the meeting as also serving in the U.S. Army.

Being that I have worked in law enforcement/intelligence most of my adulthood, I found a recent article entitled, Police Departments Opting to Buy 2024 Ford Mustang GT Coupes. I was reminded that the only American V8-powered, rear-wheel drive coupe is the Mustang because the Chevy Camaro and the Dodge Charger/Challenger have been discontinued. The North Carolina State Highway Patrol (NCHP) purchased a couple dozen 2024 Ford Mustang GT coupes. In addition, South Carolina and Georgia have announced they will also be purchasing a number of 2024 Ford Mustang GT coupes to help combat speeding. "Police have found a sweet spot," said Erich Merkle, U.S. sales analyst at Ford. With Dodge and Chevrolet discontinuing their V8-powered cars, The Blue Oval provides troopers with an effective way to catch super speeders out on the interstate.

The Detroit Free Press reported, "The Mustang has a history with the Georgia State Patrol. Our first Mustangs were used in the late '80s into the early '90s and it is exciting to see a blue-and-gray Mustang out patrolling the Georgia roadways again." Some of you may remember a TV show called "CHIPs" where the 82 SSP was featured. I read that a massive order from the California Highway Patrol (CHP) was realized in 1982. Interestingly, "Despite the attention-grabbing paint, the 1993 Mustangs used by CHP had identical drivelines and suspensions as the 5.0 Mustang GT available to the public (The Mustang – Forty Year History). While in the army working narcotics, all I got to drive that was cool was a 1976 BMW 2002; never a Mustang.

Ford released the first police-issue Mustang SSP in 1982 with a high-output, 5.0-liter V8 plus heavy-duty stabilizers and front disk brakes for improved handling at pursuit speeds. Built from 1982 to 1993, the SSP was the one Mustang you didn't want

to see in your rearview mirror: the Police Mustang as reported by Hagerty. To this day, the Utah Highway Patrol's website recounts a story of a chase that abruptly ended when a Mustang joined the pursuit. When asked why he stopped, the suspect responded, "I knew I could outrun those other patrol cars, but I can't outrun a Mustang." That story might be apocryphal, but in early 1986 one Utah trooper pursued and stayed with the fleeing motorcyclist at speeds up to 130 mph.

The moral of this story – be careful out there if you decide to speed in your souped-up Mustang – you may be pulled over by a trooper driving a souped-up Mustang. As always, please continue to pray for our dear brothers and sisters who are ill.
