## SEPTEMBER 2024 MEETING MINUTES

A note from Randy

Greetings Fellow Mustang Enthusiasts,

Sehr Geehrte Damen Und Herren (Dear ladies and gentlemen). My comments below are inspired by a recent trip Dorinda and I took to Germany. The purpose of this trip was to search the countryside for the Ford Mustang. Oh, and to also see as much of Germany as possible. Interestingly, the introduction of the 6th generation Mustang in 2015 was a turning point for Germans because of enhancements in technology, design and performance appealed more to Europeans.

The trip lasted a mere thirteen days and was full of adventure. Dorinda previously lived in Germany for a couple of years in the late 1960's. Her dad was in the U.S. Army and stationed at Bad Tolz (near the Alps) teaching Special Forces troops. She fondly remembered skiing and riding her bike through the countryside. I was stationed in Sieglesbach performing high weapons security as a Military Policeman from 1982-1984. I drank a lot of Stuttgarter Hofbrau (beer).

Our recent adventure started in Frankfurt for a welcome dinner and then to Cologne the following day. While walking to the Cologne Cathedral (Cathedral Church of Saint Peter) I was surprised to see a Mach E. I thought that was cool, but I was really hoping to see some vintage Mustangs. I held my breath. Bye the way, construction of the church began in 1248; it is the tallest twin-spired church in the world also making it the third tallest church in the world.



Berlin was our next destination. While riding a high-speed train to Berlin, Dorinda and I passed through Wolfsburg and saw the Wolfsburg Volkswagen Factory. This is the worldwide headquarters of the Volkswagen Group which is the largest car company in the world. Around 61,880 people are employed at the Wolfsburg plant.

My quest for vintage Mustangs came to a head when I spotted this beauty walking near our hotel in Berlin. I wish I could have formally interviewed this driver to learn how he acquired it. It really looked good to me.



How about this beauty we spotted in Berlin? The Trabant is known as "a spark plug with a roof." This car had a two-stroke engine that was capable of accelerating from zero to its top speed of 62 mph in only twenty-one seconds. It was a plastic car manufactured in the former East Germany and only survived thanks to government subsidies. Plastic was made from recycled cotton waste from the Soviet Union and phenol resins from the East German dye industry. This car was spotted in Berlin. I learned that East Germans wages were higher for laborers than their doctor and engineer comrades.



Off to Dresden to see the Zwinger Palace, a masterpiece of Baroque architecture. It is also where Dorinda professionally posed next to this Mustang. Note Dorinda's attire and the cool personalized license plate.

The trip ended in Frankfurt, and I saw this from my hotel.

Mustangs spotted but not photographed included a GT500 in Rotenburg, a Fox body in Berlin, and a Shelby near Potsdam. There was also one Maverick and a stinking Camero near Birnau.

Random thoughts – The first vehicle produced in Germany was in1885. Gas prices are \$7.50 a gallon in Germany. Parts of the autobahn in East Berlin were not repaired after WWII meaning drivers dodged damaged roads at only 30 mph; these roads have since been repaired following the reunification of Germany.

I hope those who attended the Legendary Mustang Sanctuary Car Cruise and Scavenger Hunt had a great time. And, I hope to see everyone at our Fall Cruise on October 5th. I am still looking for any documents of historical interest regarding our club. I would gladly make copies of what you have if you do not want to part with your original documents.
